Animá Studentship courses provide not only the clarity and insight – but also the practical information, tools and skills needed for more enlivened, proactive and personally fulfilling lives. And in the case of the Herbal Tradition courses, the ways and means to also become the most effective and responsive healers and herbalists possible. Whether Lifeways or Herbal, the intent of these courses is increased wholeness and maximized awareness, response-ability, real world manifestation and utilization. As a result, the course assignments are considered even more important than the questions and readings, requiring that every new insight be acted on and every new skill and tool applied. Each 8 Week Course will include:

- Assigned Readings by your Animá teachers
- Self-Exploratory Questions – for you to consider and then respond to
- Useful Techniques & Practices – for you to try, and then to describe the results of
- Assignments – for testing and manifesting what's learned, finding of ways in your daily life to apply what is learned to further your quest, practice, path or purpose
- Plus one or more in-depth teacher/student exchanges, clarifying, affirming, adding to, and furthering... with sometimes additional personalized assignments

Requirements:

- Your intention, attention, openness and focus
- A strong commitment to complete the course readings and assignments, and to utilizing what you learn in your daily life
- A suggested donation, whether sent at once, or pledged over time

This place and work depend on your support, even more so because the Center doesn't demand payment before helping like most places do.

Suggested Sliding Scale Donation:

- \$150 to \$350 sliding scale depending on your ability to contribute and how much you value what is offered
- Those who can are asked to send the entire amount when applying
- Those unable to donate the complete amount at once, are asked to please send as much as they can at the time of registration, and a pledge to send the remainder as soon as they are able, even if only a little at a time
- If you feel you cannot offer at least the minimum suggested amount, please apply anyway, explaining your financial situation and intentions
